



Register Now: The ADAC Velotour 2026 Kicks Off on May 1st

Following the great success of this year's ADAC Velotour, registration for the cycling classic on May 1st, 2026 is now open. As the last three editions sold out, early registration is worthwhile in several ways: those who sign up now not only benefit from discounted early bird prices starting at €59, but also secure a guaranteed spot on their preferred route. The ADAC Velotour 2026 once again offers three proven routes tailored to different ambitions. The approximately 40-kilometer ADAC Velotour Skyline runs through Eschborn, Frankfurt, and Oberursel, and is especially suited for beginners. Those seeking a more athletic challenge will find it in the ADAC Velotour Taunus Express, which covers about 90 kilometers and includes the climb up the Feldberg. Ambitious participants looking for a true pro-level experience should opt for the ADAC Velotour Taunus Classic – including the notorious Mammolshain climb.

In addition to a starting place, participants can book an attractive souvenir package during registration. This includes a personalized medal engraving and professional route photos to capture the memories of May 1st in a special way. It is also possible to pre-order the official 2026 ADAC Velotour jersey.

Ride and Do Good

In 2026, the ADAC Velotour will once again combine athletic commitment with social responsibility. Participants can choose to donate the so-called "Nachwuchseuro" when registering to support young sporting talents in Hesse. Alternatively, or in addition a tree donation can be made to support the Herzenswald Schmitten project. Around 500 new trees are expected to be planted there in autumn 2025 – 204 of them representing every kilometer of the professional race, while ADAC Velotour participants contributed an impressive 286 trees. Over the past three years, a total of 1,235 trees have been planted through this initiative.

Anyone wanting to get in the saddle on May 1st, 2026 should register early – for an unforgettable experience on one of Germany's most beautiful cycling routes.
