



Registration for Škoda Velotour 2024 started

After the huge success of the Škoda Velotour this year, registration for May 1, 2024 is already starting. With 8,000 registrations, the event as part of the Eschborn-Frankfurt German classic was already fully booked several weeks in advance. Being quick is not only worthwhile for this reason - those who book early also register at a low price. Starting places for one of the biggest hobby cycling races in Germany are now available at www.skoda-velotour.de.

In 2024, the Škoda Velotour will again offer the established courses Taunus Classic, Taunus Express and Skyline route. Beginners are best advised to opt for the approximately 40-kilometer, flat route from Eschborn to downtown Frankfurt and back. For all early bookers, a ride is available for as little as 45 euros.

The two longer Škoda Velotour rounds lead through the Taunus region. For all routes, the roads belong entirely to the Velotour participants, as the course is completely closed off. The Classic route cracks the delightful 100-kilometer mark and leads over the decisive climbs of the elite Eschborn-Frankfurt race, the Feldberg and the Mammolshainer Stich. Somewhat shorter at around 90 kilometers is the express loop, which skips the detour to Mammolshain. As in previous years, the two long distances will again be timed on the ascent of the Feldberg to crown the Tissot Bergkönig and Bergkönigin.

Those who book a starting place now will not only secure the low price, but can also do good at the same time. Every time you register for the Škoda Velotour, you have the opportunity to donate a tree in the Herzenswald Schmitten forest northwest of Frankfurt. For a minimum donation of 10 euros, each participant can adopt a new tree that will be planted in the fall of 2024.
